

NORTH-EAST WALES BIRD REPORT 2024

The main objectives of this Report are to record unusual sightings, breeding evidence, arrival and departure dates of non-resident species and high counts for each species, and to acknowledge the efforts of people submitting data. Special thanks to the small number of people who submitted the majority of valuable records. Incomplete coverage means breeding numbers of all species are greatly-underestimated, as shown by the much larger numbers of nesting Curlew, Lapwing, Black Grouse and Swift found by special 2024 surveys. It is striking that only one confirmed breeding report was received for Woodpigeon, one of our most abundant and least secretive of birds, and that few nesting sites for Swifts this year would be known without the "Swift Recovery Survey" promoted by the North Wales Wildlife Trust (NWWT).

The Report is based almost entirely on data provided in spreadsheet form by Cofnod (Aisling May), BTO (especially Birdtrack [inc. Birdguides (Bg)] but also Garden Birdwatch, BBS, WBBS and WeBS) and eBird, plus other sources that include Julian Hughes (WOS), RSPB [especially Graham Jones and Colin Wells], NWWT, Peter Coffey and the Merseyside Ringing Group, Deeside Naturalists Society Report 2024 and direct submissions. Special thanks to Julian Hughes for keeping me on the right track and always knowing where to look for information.

The number of bird records has soared in recent years to over 150,000 this year, including over 110,000 Birdtrack records, nearly 33,000 eBird records and over 7,000 from other sources.

Unusual records for 2024 include a long-staying Hudsonian Godwit (a first for Wales), American Golden Plover, Smew, Long-tailed Duck, Sabine's, Caspian and Glaucous Gulls, Roseate and Black Terns, Black Guillemot, White-tailed Sea-eagle (seen again), Woodlark, Waxwing and Lapland Bunting.

The Report this year contains the Ringing Report for both 2023 and 2024 from Lee Barber (BTO).

Wetland Bird Survey


The Wetland Bird Survey (WeBS) monitors the UK's internationally important non-breeding waterbirds. Following a tradition begun in 1947, volunteers and surveyors count wetland sites once per month, providing data for population and trends in abundance and distribution. The network of sites legally protected for their importance to wintering waterbirds depends fundamentally on the WeBS counts. This report presents information for species where there is significant data available from this year's WeBS surveys. Counts are included where they equal or exceed a threshold number which is considered to be important in the context of North East Wales. We are extremely grateful to all those who carry out the counts, not least because these are amongst the most important data collected for conservation purposes. The Maps

This year data from Birdtrack, eBird and Cofnod have been used to create the computer-generated maps. Only observations made within 1km squares can be used; these have the format "SJ1234". Submissions in other formats, such as tetrad or 10km squares (e.g. "SJ07" or "SJ07C") cannot be included routinely in the maps. The maps are for illustrative purposes only and should not be used as evidence for either presence in or absence from a particular square.

The coverage map below shows all the 1km squares that have at least one record this year. Notable gaps in coverage are most Denbs uplands apart from the Brenig/Clocaenog area, much of the Maelor apart from Fenn's Moss and the southern Berwyns. Some spots outside Flints/Denbs have crept into the maps, but are not used in the main text.


Branta b. bernicula (Dark-bellied Brent Goose: Russia)

Flints. Two at Talacre on 11/02 (AJR, DEW).

Branta b. hrota (Pale-bellied Brent Goose: Svalbard, Greenland)

Flints. 36 BT records from the Dee estuary, up to 25/04 and from 31/07 onwards, including 19 from Point of Ayr where the highest count was 100 on 15/02 (eBird). Max 325 at Walwen Marsh on 7/12 (WeBS). Other records from Gronant, RSPB Oakenholt, Greenfield, Bagillt and Ffynonngroyw.

Denbs. Horton's Nose had 11 on 31/01 (GrJ) and 2 on 7/02 (SK, MP).


Canada Goose *Branta canadensis*

GŴYDD CANADA

A very common breeding resident and winter visitor.

Flints. 570 BT records in all months (156 of which from Connah's Quay NR) with breeding confirmed at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints), Rhyl Brickworks (5y), Clwyd Estuary (5y + 2y), Gronant (2pr, 16y), Big Pool Wood, Buckley Common (3y + 2y), Nannerch Fishery (3y), Star Crossing Pool (6y), Llanfynydd and Hawarden Golf Course. Max 4000 at CQNR-OakRSPB on 3/02 (PSH), 500 at Point of Ayr on 18/09 (eBird) and 387 at Clwyd estuary on 2/02 (JHi).

Denbs. 832 BT records in all months (338 of which were from RSPB Conwy). Breeding was confirmed at RSPB Conwy (4 families: 4y, 4y, 2y: WRM), Llyn Brenig (1y: WRM), Llyn Aled



Isaf (WRM), Bodnant NT (VBeaney), Esclusham Mtn (NF), Acton Park-Wrexham (PaJ), Gresford Flash (JmHu) and Lower Mountain, Hope (IMS). Max 400 at Rhyl Marine Lake on 9/11 (WeBS).

GŴYDD WYRAN

Uncommon winter visitor, probably of feral origin.

Flints. 7 BT records. Max 4 at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints) on 7/03 (CW) and 3 at Cop Hole Pool on 21/01 (AHJ) and singles at CQNR-OakRSPB on 19/02 and 14/03 (PSH), Shotwick on 19/02 (JmHu) and Fagl Lane on 10/01 (eBird).

Denbs. One at Holt on 25/01 (NF).

Greylag Goose Anser anser


GŴYDD LWYD

A common breeding resident and winter visitor.

Flints. 361 BT records in all months, with breeding confirmed at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints), Gronant on 30/05 (2 pairs; WRM), Clwyd estuary on 12/05 (WRM), Fagl Lane on 15/06 (PaJ), Hawarden golfcourse on 2/06 (SD) and Star Crossing on 4/05 (pair + 6y: GEM, MP). Max 800 on Clwyd estuary on 9/11 (WeBS), 685 at Rhuddlan on 5/10 (JeN) and 470 at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints) on 14/10 (CW).

Denbs

383 BT records in all months. Breeding was confirmed at RSPB Conwy on 19/07 (MAO), Nannerch Fishery on 9/06 (3y and 5y: GEM), Lleweni on 30/04 (3-4 broods: JHi), Nant-y-Ffrith on 23/06 (10y: SD), Plas-yn-fron on 3/05 and PenYCae on 6/06 (both JmHu). Max 350 at Holt on 25/01 (NF).


Pink-footed Goose *Anser brachyrhynchus*

GŴYDD DROETBINC

Abundant, but local, winter visitor in increasing numbers and becoming regular at inland sites.

Flints. 179 BT records (51 from CQNR-OakRSPB), up to 4/05 and then from 13/09 onwards, apart from stray summer singles. Max 6060 at CQNR-OakRSPB on 11/02 (PSH) and 5500 at White Sands on 23/02 (GrJ). Gronant car park fields had 120 on 23/02 and 430 on 23/12 (both WRM), 300 at Rhuddlan on 23/02 (SHu) and 270 at Shotwick Lake on 14/09 (SD). 450 flew over the A55 at Rhuallt on 1/11 (SuHa), 350 flew over Hawarden Ind Park on 20/01 (AHJ) and 200 flew over Gronant on 23/02 (WRM).

Denbs. 21 BT records, up to 25/03 and then from 22/08 onwards. Highest counts in fields behind Pensarn of 3000 on 15/02 (TGr) and 1000 on 28/01 (MSm) and 14/02 (MBo), with 164 on the Clwyd estuary on 7/01 (JHi).



Modest numbers at Is-Y-Coed with max 100 on 6/01 (JmHu), 8-9 at Lleweni throughout March (JHi) and 8 at Nannerch Fishery on 16/01 (MD).

GWYDD DALCENWEN


A scarce winter visitor.

Denbs. One among Pink-feet flock in fields at Belgrano on 14/02 (MBo), 2 in a nearby area of Morfa Rhuddlan on 28/01 (MSm) and 2 in Borras Park, Wrexham on 9/11 (eBird).

Mute Swan Cygnus olor Common breeding resident.

Flints. 530 BT records with breeding confirmed at Gronant, Rhyl Brickworks Pool and Rhuddlan NR. Max 42 on Clwyd estuary on 18/09 (MaS).

Denbs. 526 BT records with confirmed breeding at Hanmer, Erddig, Rhewl and Pentre Mawr Park. Max 46 at Rhyl Marine Lake on 19/12 (AHJ).

ALARCH BEWICK

ALARCH DOF

Very scarce winter visitor.

Flints. One at White Sands and Cop Hole on 2/02 (GrJ) was at Shotton Pools NR on the same day (OwP).


Whooper Swan Cygnus cygnus

ALARCH Y GOGLEDD

Uncommon, but regular, winter visitor, mainly to the Dee estuary.

Flints. 62 BT records with a max of 30 on 11/10 (AHJ: "Flew over R.Clwyd east towards Dyserth/Prestatyn"), 24 at Shotton Lagoons on 4/02 (eBird), 22 on the Clwyd estuary on 10/10 (RiE), 17 at White Sands on 6/12 (CW), 15 on RSPB Burton Mere (Flints) on 2/11(CW) and 13 at Burton MOD marsh on 7/01 (CW: "Flew over from roost at BMW to White Sands"). At CQNR, a bird with a damaged wing was present from 22/02 to 5/05, often with a flock of Mute Swans (PSH *et al*). One was at Gronant from 15/10 to 24/10 (many obs) and one at Fagl Lane on 10/01 (OwP).

Denbs. 5 BT records only. 12 on the R. Dee at Pontcysyllte on 8/01 (DaHu), 3 at Rhyl Matine Lake on 28/11 (MaS), 6 at Holt on 25/01 (NF), 10 at RSPB Conwy on 16/11 (MP) and 6 there on 13/12 (SaE).



Egyptian Goose Alopochen aegyptiaca Uncommon visitor; introduced in 18thC.

GŴYDD YR AIFFT

Flints. On 18/05, a family party of 7 was at both Cop Hole Pool and Burton MOD (AHJ). On 17/11, a party of 4 was at Cop Hole Pool (AHJ). Four further records in this area of 1-3 birds during Jan-Feb and Oct-Dec. One at Clwyd estuary on 30/11 (JHi).


Shelduck Tadorna tadorna

HWYADEN YR EITHIN

A fairly-common breeding resident locally and very common year-round visitor, with peak numbers during the summer moult on the Dee estuary.


Flints. 552 BT records (of which 136 from CQNR-OakRSPB and 151 from Clwyd estuary) with max. 1070 at POA on 18/10 (JHg) and 430 at CQNR-OakRSPB on 28/06 (GEM). Breeding was confirmed at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints) and on the Clwyd estuary on 30/06: "3prs with 5, 5 and 4 ducklings" (WRM).

Denbs. 397 BT records, inc 310 at RSPB Conwy. Confirmed breeding at Bettisfield on 2/07 (RHa: pr +8y) and on the Conwy estuary with 5-7 young on 25/06, 3/07 and 14/07 (WRM JHg, ABa). Max. 65 at RSPB Conwy on 31/03 (JHg).




Gadwall Mareca strepera HWYADEN LWYD

An uncommon, but increasing, breeding resident (introduced).

Flints. Only 13 BT records in 5 locations: Max. 9 at Afonwen on 14/10 (MV), 4 at Fforest Farm-Cilcain on 1/05 (GEM), pair at Star Crossing from 3/02 to 31/03 (GEM, MP, MD), pair at Fagl Lane on 25/03 (JmHu) and a male at Y Ddol NR on 2/05 (AHJ). Breeding was confirmed near Llanfynydd on 10/06 (4y: eBird).

Denbs. 88 BT records in all months. Breeding was confirmed in 4 locations: Erddig, Lleweni, Pontcysyllte and Llangollen. Max 17 at Wynnstay Park on 2/06 (GBW), 14 at Maes Mynan on 16/10 (MV) and 12 on the Dee near Pontcysyllte on 2/03 (DaPh) and 7/05 (DaHu).



Garganey Anas querquedula

HWYADEN ADDFAIN

A very scarce passage migrant.

Flints. One at Connah's Quay NR on 6/05 (eBird: also near Shotwick), 5/06 (Bg) and 24/07 (MP). A breeding plumage male at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints) on 6/05 and 18/05, a pair there on 7/09 (all AHJ) and max 3 on 13/08 (eBird).


Shoveler Anas clypeata

HWYADEN LYDANBIG

Local breeding resident and fairly common winter visitor to freshwater locations.

Flints. 156 BT records (including 51 at CQNR-OakRSPB) in all months of the year. The only nesting site was RSPB Burton Mere (Flints), where 24 pairs were present though no broods were recorded (GrJ). Max 95 on flooded Burton MOD marshes on 18/10 (CW) and 43 at Cop Hole Pool on 16/08 (AHJ). Also 25 at both CQNR on 9/03 (PSH) and Llay on 30/03 (SD), 20 at Talacre on 27/02 and 16/12 (RCR) and 14 at Star Crossing on 11/03 (MP).


Denbs. 369 BT records (including 315 at RSPB Conwy) in all months of the year. Max 54 at both RSPB Conwy on 20/10 (JoPr) and Fenn's Moss on 8/04 (RHa). Inland, 20 at Maes Mynan on 1/01 (SK).



Flints. 168 BT records in all months of the year. Breeding was confirmed at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints) with 17 pairs. The highest BT count was 34 at Cop Hole Pool on 22/10 (AHJ). Other records from CQNR, Shotwick Lake, Gronant, Afonwen, Mancot, RSPB Burton Mere (Wales), Point of Ayr, Talacre and Rhyl Brickworks. Max 61 at Shotwick Lake on 12/01 (WeBS).

A fairly common and increasing breeding resident and winter visitor.

Denbs. 417 BT records, 392 of which were from RSPB Conwy. Breeding was confirmed at RSPB Conwy with a nest with 6 young seen on 14/07 (JHg). The highest count was 60 at RSPB Conwy on 16/01 (TGr). Other records from Llay, Maes Mynan, Clwyd estuary, Trevalyn Meadows, Fagl Lane and Erddig.


Wigeon Mareca penelope

CHWIWELL

An abundant winter visitor to estuaries and wetlands.

Flints. 362 BT records (143 of them from CQNR-OakRSPB) in all months, inc 6 that summered at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints). Max. 2500 at Burton MOD marshes on 21/10 (CW) and 2000 at CQNR-OakRSPB on 17/01 and 20/01 (PSH), 500 at Talacre on 15/12 (RCR) and 387 at Clwyd estuary on 20/01 (JHi). Inland, 35 at Whitford Lodge pool on 7/01(ShN).

Denbs. 309 BT records (257 from RSPB Conwy). Max 220 at Holt on 12/01 (WeBS), 160 at RSPB Conwy on 30/01 (TGr), 71 at Hanmer on 14/01 (DaHa) and 68 on Rhyl Marine Lake on 15/12 (JHi).

Mallard Anas platyrhynchos An abundant breeding resident and winter visitor. **HWYADEN WYLLT**

Flints. 957 BT records with breeding confirmed at 10 locations (Clwyd estuary, Gronant, Rhyl Brickworks, Deeside Ind. Estate, Rhuddlan NR, R. Elwy at St Asaph, Saltney Ferry, Cop Hole Pool, Hawarden, Nercwys Forest and Star Crossing). Max 527 at CQNR-OakRSPB on 18/08 (PSH), 400 there on 8/06 (PSH) and 385 there on 10/07 (GEM) and 118 at Rhyl Brickworks on 18/12 (AHJ).

Denbs. 968 BT records throughout the year. Successful breeding at 13 locations (RSPB Conwy, Pensarn, Pentre Mawr Park, Bodnant, Maes Ffynnon Pool-Rhuthun, Acton Park-Wrexham, Llanddulas, Sontley, Erddig, Llyn Brenig, Pulford Brook, Bangor-on-Dee, Peny-Cae, Acrefair, Moss Valley CP and Maes Mynan). Max. 90 at Erddig on 10/08 (WeBS),

63 at Maes Ffynnon Pool-Rhuthun on 6/06 (GoP) and 60 at Hanmer on 19/11 (DaHa).


Pintail Anas acuta

HWYADEN LOSTFAIN

A very rare breeding resident and an abundant winter visitor to estuaries and wetlands.

Flints. 86 BT records (26 from CQNR-OakRSPB) up to 31/03and again from 7/09 onwards (apart from 2 summering birds). Pair plus 1M summered at RSPB Burton Mere (Flints) but no broods recorded (GrJ). Max 400 at Point of Ayr on 9/11 (WeBS).

Denbs. 26 BT records (inc 15 from RSPB Conwy), up to 21/03 and again from 19/09 onwards (apart from 2 summering birds). Max 350 at Holt on 12/01 (WeBS) and 107 at Lleweni on 12/02 (JHi).





A rare breeding resident and an abundant winter visitor to estuaries and wetlands.

Flints. 485 BT records (177 of which from CQNR-OakRSPB) throughout the year. Max 2000 at CQNR-OakRSPB on 7/09 (WeBS), 500 at Burton MOD marsh on 21/10 (CW), 320 at Talacre on 22/10 (RCR), 150+ on flooded fields at Llanrhaeadr on 22/01 (GoP) and 151 at Point of Ayr on 27/01 (MaS).

Denbs. 454 BT records (inc 346 from RSPB Conwy) throughout the year. No evidence of breeding. Max. 299 at RSPB Conwy on 7/09 (WeBS).






Black Grouse *Lyrurus tetrix Uncommon resident of upland heather moors.*

Flints. The only BT records were in the Fauxdegla/Moel Garegog area adjacent to Ruabon Moors with 12 on 21/03 (MP), singles on 8/05 and 11/07 (MP) and 14/08 (JaSh). Up to 12 lekking males were present there on 18/04 (Anya). A survey of Flints moorland near Moel Famau on 25/04 found up to 9 lekking males (Cofnod) and 6 males were seen there on 2/02 (JaP).

Denbs. 66 BT records, with breeding evidence limited to lekking males, including 57 BT records from Esclusham Mountain to Worlds End, where the highest overall count was 48 on 1/05 (NF). RHOSTOG HUDSON

Very rare vagrant, breeding in northern Canada and Alaska.

Flints. A first record for Wales. 67 BT records during 12/08-5/09 (and 18 eBird records). It was found on the CQNR bunded pools with Black-tailed Godwits by Geoff Robinson on the evening of 12/08 before it flew across the river to RSPB Burton Mere where the ID was confirmed by Colin Wells on 13/08. It returned to the Reserve on 14/08 where it consorted with a large flock of Black-tailed Godwits most days (apart from 18-19/08 when it went to RSPB Burton Mere) until 9/09. Many photographs were taken, both from close to West Hide and from the Flint side of Oakenholt Marsh. It was later seen on the Mersey at Hale, near Liverpool Airport, on 27/09.

Denbs. 548 BT records, inc 427 from RSPB Conwy. Breeding was confirmed with 8 or 9 nests at Tal-y-cafn near Conwy on 28/05 (WRM). Although there were counts of up to 60 at RSPB Conwy, such high Conwy counts will include the Benarth heronry across the



river in Caernarvon. Elsewhere, max 14 at Rhyl Marine Lake on 21/07 (JHi).



GWALCH PYSGOD

A very scarce breeding resident and passage migrant.

Flints. One at Gronant on 6/09 (JaH) was the only BT record.

Denbs. Of 69 BT records from 31/03 to 5/09, 66 were at or near the Llyn Brenig nest site where "a pair, LJ2 and LM6, fledged 2 young on 23/07 (named Blue 7B5 Dilys & Blue 7B6 Mari). Two chicks hatched at Llyn Brenig also returned to North Wales. KA5 Roli (male, hatched 2019) has been spotted looking for a nest and a female of his own for the past three years, and KC5 Dwynwen (female, hatched 2020) returned for the first time this year. She actually landed on the Brenig nest" briefly (NWWT Osprey Project). Singles at Llyn Aled and Aled Isaf on 19/04 (JHg), RSPB Conwy on 2/04 (TGr) and Bodnant on 1/06 (eBird).



A fairly common breeding resident that often takes advantage of garden bird feeders (there were 346 Garden Birdwatch (GBW) records across all months of the year, with fewest in May).

Flints. 206 BT records, but no confirmed breeding. Max. 4 at Rhuddlan NR on 13/04 (SHu). In Pantymwyn, one was "perched on house scaffolding as it hunted through gardens" on 2/04 (GEM). A female took a male blackbird at Rhydymwyn NR on 19/03 (IMo). GBW had 168 records in 16 garden locations.

Denbs. 90 BT records but no confirmed breeding. Max. count 2 at RSPB Conwy on 24/02 (TGr), Eglwyseg on 29/05 (NiSu) and Pwllglas on 30/04 (ABar: one female in display flight). One was "mobbed by 4 swallows" at Llechrydau on 8/07 (GEM). One took a house sparrow in a Denbigh town centre garden on 7/05 (Rachel Jones). GBW had 178 records in 35 garden locations.





A scarce breeding resident, possibly increasing. Flints. Only 3 BT records; 2 sightings at

Nercwys Forest on 4/03 (DWin) and 22/06 (DaFr) and one in the Chwiler Valley near Ddol on 24/06 (SK), although there were 3 Chwiler valley sightings across the border in Denbs.

Denbs. 29 records, inc. 15 in the well-known Clocaenog Forest/Llyn Brenig area during Jan-July and Dec. There was a record of courtship display at Bron Banog on 3/03 ("probable" breeding) and the max. count of 5 there (MBo). Other counts here of 3 on 12/04 (JJo) and 2 on both 5/03 (SK) and 1/06 (DaFr). An adult female was seen perched on a post in a forest clearing near Llyn Brenig on




1/01 (GrJ). A female soaring with a buzzard near Llanelidan on 26/04 (ABar) and one in the Elwy valley near Llanfair TH on 9/11. Four records of singles at World's End on 22/03 (Maya), 1/04 (ShH), 1/05 (NF) and 26/09 (IMoo). Three singles at Maes Mynan in the Chwiler valley on 10/01 (MV), 19/01 (male: KBr) and 23/10 (MV). One at RSPB Conwy on 22/12 (RoH, NOH). A male flying low near the R. Alyn on 6/01 (DWin), 1 at Pentrefoelas on 6/03 (ScUp) and a juvenile landing in an Abergele garden on 3/08 (MBo).

Marsh Harrier *Circus aeruginosus* Resident on the Dee estuary and migrant. BODA'R GWERNI

Flints. 130 BT records (34 at CQNR-OakRSPB and 26 at Gronant) in all months except June but no breeding evidence submitted. The only 2 records specifically of males were at Cop Hole and Burton MOD marsh. Counts of 3 at Gronant on 7/02 (RiE) and at Cop Hole on 3/09 and 5/09 (AHJ). CQNR-OakRSPB had 3 together over the fly ash lagoon on 26/11 (SuHa) and one with a red wing-tag on 18/08 (AHJ). Point of Ayr/Talacre had 3 records on 6/01 (FrG), 31/07 (PSw) and 7/11 (HeCa).

Denbs. 11 BT records in Jan-May and Sep/Oct, (8 from Fenn's Moss/Bettisfield) with no breeding evidence submitted and no males reported. Singles at Fenn's Moss on 29/03, 17/04, 11/05, 28/09, 12/10 and 22/10 (all RHa). Singles at RSPB Conwy on 4/02 (JeN), offshore at Towyn on 6/01 (MBo) and at Trefriw on 7/03 (ScUp).



Hen Harrier *Circus cyaneus*

BODA TINWYN

A very scarce breeding resident in upland areas, a scarce passage migrant and an uncommon winter visitor to the estuaries.

Flints. 22 BT winter records during Jan-Feb and Oct-Dec (except 2 in Apr, 1 in Aug). Four ringtail records at Burton MOD marsh from 27/01 to 18/02 (CW) and 1 there on 30/11 (AHJ), 11/02 and 15/12 (both GrJ), at Cop Hole on 2/02 (GrJ), 24/02 and 4/04 (both AHJ) and at CQNR-OakRSPB on 24/01 (PSH), 9/04 (AW) and 23/12 (AHJ). One at Clwyd estuary on 21/08 (AHJ), at Gronant on 17/10 and 29/12 (Bg) and at Point of Ayr on 23/12 (Bg).

Denbs. 37 BT records in all months except Jan. A survey of the north Berwyns (Denbs) recorded 6 nests again with 17y fledged (KO per JHg). Four young fledged from two nests on Mynydd Hiraethog, but all 3 nests at Migneint (Denbs) failed this year (KO per JHg). A sky-dancing pair displayed at Mynydd Hiraethog on 16/05 (HeJo) and a male was "followed on" by a Merlin here on 18/04 (ChMe). 3 BT records from Llyn Brenig in May and Oct, which included confirmed breeding with a bird carrying food on 6/05 (Maya), are thought to relate to the Mynydd Hiraethog birds, as are 4 BT records from Llyn Aled-Aled Isaf in Mar, Jul and Oct and 3 BT records from Llansannan on 3/03 (male), 16/07 and 6/09. Max 3 at World's End on 20/04 (DaFr) and 13 other records of 1-2 birds there (10 of them in Apr-May: many obs), including a displaying pair on 1/05 (NF). Singles at Llyn Bran on 3/12 (RTe), Fenn's Moss on 10/08 (RHa), Pentrefoelas on 5/05 and Ysbyy Ifan on 8/05 (both MAO). A male in the Clwydians on 10/10 (GoP: "perfect view of male hunting low above ground - hillside above Llyn Gweryd").


Visitor and breeding resident, now more common and widespread, although numbers are still small in the north.

Flints. 40 BT records, in all months except Feb (mainly Apr-Jun), but no breeding evidence. Max 3 at Bagillt on 27/06 (GRMP). Two at Broughton on 12/05 were identified as 2CY (AHJ).

Denbs. 196 BT records from all months (mainly Mar-Jun). Two nests near Pentrefoelas were successful

(3y and 1y: KHJ). All of 1-4 birds except max. 6 at Bryneglwys on 26/03 (MP). A GBW location near Cefn Du had summer visits on 3 occasions.



Flints. 429 BT records with breeding confirmed by an adult with a begging juvenile near the Clwyd estuary south of Rhyl on 25/08 (WRM); "probable" breeding at 3 further locations. Max 6 both at Penycloddiau on 1/04 (MP) and at Clwyd estuary on both 19/02 (AHJ) and 22/02 (KBr).

Denbs. 717 BT records without breeding confirmation, although 4 calling birds at Chirk Castle on 1/08 were considered a likely family party. "Probable" nesting (as far as "courtship display") at 11 locations. Max 8 at Craig Bron Banog on 12/04 (JJo). At Fenn's Moss, one was seen carrying off a likely Curlew chick on 16/06, mobbed by a Curlew and 2 Lapwings (RH) and one was mobbed by 2 Kestrels and a Curlew as it circled above on 8/07 (RH).

Scarce breeding resident.

Flints. 12 BT records during Jan-Jul and Sep-Dec. Breeding was confirmed from 4 nestboxes in Flints which raised 10 ringed young (IMS). One was found dead by the A494 Queensferry roundabout on 17/12, having been seen nearby earlier on 3/10 (JGre), close to 1 flying near A494 Garden City on 18/06 (KaM). One was seen on both early and late BBS walks at nearby Sandycroft. Another was found dead by the A55 at St Asaph on 18/03 (LeWi). Singles at Rhydymwyn NR on both 25/04 (StW) and 18/10 (IMo), near Holywell Common on 29/07 (MaCa), Gronant on 26/03 (KBo), on a fence by the A548 at Gwespyr on 3/01 (AB), near the A55 ay Pen-y-Cefn on 23/12 (JHg), Glan-yr-Afon on 3/02 and 27/03 (ShN), Cop Hole on 26/10 and 30/10 (AHJ), Walwen



Denbs. 4 BT records. No confirmed breeding, but 2 together north of Llyn Aled Isaf at dusk on 6/04 and 1 there on 3/03 (both JoW). One at Bylchau on 3/03 (MP) and 3 records at Fenns Moss on 11/01, 21/10 and 22/10 (all RHa). In the Clwydians, 1 was seen



Denbs. 36 BT records. Breeding was confirmed at Froncysyllte on 10/05 (TK: 1y on a telegraph pole), Llanfair TH on 17/07 (MAO) and "probable" at Eglwyseg on 1/06 (NiSu). One was mobbed by blackbirds at Minera Quarry NR on 11/05 (JacK). There were summer (May-July) BT records in 10 locations. Max. 6 at Gwytherin on 15/02 (ZacR) and 4 at Maeshafn on 24/01 (DWin).





A winter pair was seen at Cop Hole Pool on several occasions (AHJ). 12 records at Cop Hole Pool, 8 records at CQNR-OakRSPB, 6 records at Point of Ayr and 3 records at Gronant. A male at Moel Llys-y-Coed on 23/02 (DWin). Also recorded at Clwyd estuary, Burton MOD marshes, Flint castle and Shotwick Lake.

Denbs. 14 BT records. A survey area in the North Berwyns had only one nest which fledged 4 young, but 5 other known territories were unoccupied this year (KO per JHg). No other evidence of breeding apart from a pair present on Mynydd Hiraethog on 16/05 (HeJo). The only other May-July




records were 1 near Llyn Aled/Aled Isaf on 6/05 (JuWi, JmHu) and 1 on a BBS walk in the Berwyns on 6/05. Elsewhere on Mynydd Hiraethog, a female was following-on a hunting male hen harrier on 18/04 (ChMe). Singles at Fenn's Moss, World's End, Lleweni, Rhewl and Llantysilio Mtn. At Bryn Alyn on 16/09, one flew "from Eryrys towards Maeshafn at telegraph pole level, with a brief dash at a small bird on the pole" (GEM). Hobby Falco subbuteo

A rare breeding visitor and scarce passage migrant.

Flints. 15 BT records (all singles) from 6/05 to 4/10, including 5 records at Cop Hole in May and Sep (all AHJ) and 3 records at Burton MOD marsh in May and Aug (all CW). Singles at CQNR-OakRSPB on 25/07 (PSH), Sealand on 27/05 (DWin), Higher Shotton on 14/07 (MaFr), the A5119 above Flint on 25/07 (AnWh), Talacre on 6/09 (JaH) and 16/09 (RCR), Plas Gwyn in the Chwiler valley on 5/07 (SK) and nearby Caerwys on 7/09 (MV). 4 eBird records of singles near Cop Hole on 6/05. Nercwys Forest on 26/05. Fauxdegla on 26/07 and RSPB Burton Border Pool on 24/09. One at St Asaph on 27/06 (JoW: "being mobbed by house martins and swallows near farm building"). The last record was at Gronant on 4/10 (per JHg).

Denbs. 38 BT records from 28/04 to 28/08. Max. 8 together at Fenn's Moss on both 20/06 and 11/08 (RHa), attracted by high dragonfly numbers. Although 15 of the 34 Fenn's Moss records were in June/July and a likely juvenile was seen on 3/08 (RHa), there was no proof of nesting within the Reserve. There were early singles at Llyn Aled Isaf on 28/04 (SK) and Llyn Brenig on 6/05 (JHi). One was seen carrying food at Bodnant on 28/05 (ToB) and one at Eglwyseg on 29/05 (NiSu). There were 3 singles at Froncysyllte on 28/06, 9/08 and 29/08 (TK), 2 singles at Moel Famau (Denbs) on 8/07 and 17/07 (TK) and further singles at Pwllglas on 5/05 (ABar), Sydallt on 25/09 (JVH) and Brynmyllt-Mynydd Hiraethog on 1/08 (ChMe).



Unusual locations were 1 over Tesco Mold car park on 19/04 (AB), seen again on a nearby BBS walk on the same day (GEM) and 1 mobbed by House Martins over Treudddyn village on 1/09.

Denbs. 55 BT records in all months of the year, with a pair in the central Berwyns on 5/05 (JmHu) and

one carrying prey at Eglwyseg on 1/06 (NiSu) the only breeding evidence. Two previous nesting sites in the North Berwyns were unoccupied or "female-only" (KO per JHg). Singles at Minera NR in Mar, Sep and Nov. A female stooping on a kestrel at Moel Famau on 26/08 (TK) and one stooping on buzzards at Bryneglwys on 8/04 (MCr). Max. 2 at RSPB Conwy, Llanddulas, Eglwyseg, Trefriw, Coedpoeth, World's End and Pensarn (where they chased a Woodpigeon out to sea: MBo).

Max 42 at Llyn Alwen on 28/01 (DWin), 30 at Clocaenog on 28/12 (DWin), 30 at Llyn Brenig-CerrigCaws on 29/02 (WRM), 25 at World's End on 26/02 (eBird), 20 at Esclusham Mtn on 27/01 (JJo) and 15 above Glyn Ceiriog on 30/12 (eBird). Unusual locations were 2 pairs feeding at Bwlchgwyn Quarry on 1/01 (SD), 8 flying over Queensferry on 20/05 (DWin), flock of 4 at Hafotty Bennett on the B5113 (RS) and 1 at Llyn Gweryd on 10/10 (GoP).





Denbs. 812 BT records with breeding confirmed at RSPB Conwy on 13/07 (RNe), Colwyn Bay on 29/08 (WRM), north of Foel Goch on 26/07 (WO) and Trefriw on 16/06 (WRM). Max. 150 feeding on knapweed at Minera NR on 11/10 (Jack) and 60 at Bryn Alyn on 16/09 (GEM).





Flints. 142 BT records with breeding confirmed at Rhydymwyn on 13/06 (MD) and Pantymwyn on 1/07 (GEM). Max 80 in a Rhydymwyn garden on 21/03, with 68 there on 12/03 (MD). Also 75 in a Broughton garden on 7/03 (AHJ) and 55 in a Pantymwyn garden on 2/03 (GEM). Penycloddiau had 40 on 31/03 and still 20 on 24/06 (eBird). 81 were ringed at Bagillt on 11/03 (GRMP) and 29 were ringed at Sychdyn on 17/02 (IMS), just a fraction of the annual total ringed at these sites (765 at Bagillt, 111 at Sychdyn).

Denbs. 284 BT records with breeding confirmed at Llyn Brenig on 11/06 and Llanrwst on 16/07 (both WRM). Max. 60+ on 2/05 at Llyn Brenig (PEM) and 50 at Hanmer on 19/11 (DaHa).



May-June records of singing males in 4 areas of Cilcain/Cilcain Moors (MP, GEM). Ffrith Farm, Treuddyn had 4 on 9/06 and max 7 on 29/12 (eBird). Singles at Fagl Lane on 10/01 (OwP), Gronant on 20/04 (MaS), CQNR on 11/05 (PSH), Dyserth on 5/06 (eBird) and near Marian Cwm on 24/06 (ShN).

Denbs. 9 BT records with no confirmed breeding. Summer singles at



One below Moel-y-Parc on Offa's Dyke Path on 20/04 (GoP). Two at Lleweni on 9/09 (JHI) and singles at Rossett on 24/03 (JoW), Cefn Du on 27/05 (RS), above Glyn Ceiriog on 4/06 (RhJ), near Llanfair TH on 28/06 (HeCaf) and near the A5 at Ystrad Bach on 23/04 (RiE).



Burton Mere, RSPB (Flints): mostly England, but Border Pool and adjacent areas are in Wales. **Bwlchgwyn** (Denbs): village with quarry and pool on the N. edge of moors west of Wrexham

Cae Llwyd (Denbs): a reservoir on the edge of the Ruabon moors near Wrexham

Cefn Du: upland area south of Colwyn Bay

Ceiriog Forest (Denbs): forestry plantation in the north Berwyns with public access

Llanfyllin (Denbs): village in a river valley south of the Berwyns

Llantysilio Mtn (Denbs): moorland area N. of Llangollen

Llay (Denbs): a large pool adjacent to Alyn Waters CP near Wrexham

Llechrydau (Denbs): traditional upland wooded farmland, SE of the Ceiriog valley in the Berwyns.

Lleweni (Denbs): Lleweni Hall between Denbigh and Bodfari (public footpaths and access to R. Clwyd)

Llyn Brenig (Denbs): a large reservoir in the Denbigh Moors, with an Osprey viewing site.

Each year licenced BTO bird ringers fit specially designed rings with unique digits to birds to help track their movements, life span, migrations and breeding performance. We have learned fascinating insights into the lives of birds since the start of the British and Irish Ringing Scheme, but there is still much that is unknown.

After a peak in the ringing totals in 2022, the number of birds ringed dropped slightly in 2023 and then dropped further in 2024. This was mainly driven by a reduction in the number of fully grown birds ringed, however the number of chicks (pulli) ringed followed the same trend although to a lesser extent. BTO analysis for Britain and Ireland shows that productivity in 2024 was generally poor for most species, which would affect the totals of fully grown birds and pulli ringed.

The totals show that 2023 was not as good a year compared to 2022 (with a decline of 1,086 birds) and 2024 showed a further decline of 1,381 birds between 2023 and 2024. The number of Blue Tits ringed in 2023 was 548 birds greater than the previous year, however during 2024 this total dropped to levels below that of 2022 (a decline of 628), with this species showing the greatest decline in the number of birds ringed in 2024. This drop in the number of Blue Tit ringed in 2024 could in part be due to low productivity and the weather generally not being conducive for ringing. Great Tit followed a similar pattern, however they didn't drop below the 2022 total like Blue Tit. Numbers of Pied

Flycatcher ringed also showed an increase in 2023 and a decline in 2024 to a very similar level to 2022.

The largest drop in the numbers of birds ringed in 2023, compared with 2022, was shown in Blackheaded Gull, with 838 birds ringed in 2022 and none in 2023. There were no Common Tern ringed in 2023 either and was due to a severe outbreak of Avian Influenza in the area which killed many individuals (see the selected recoveries list below for example). Black-headed Gull and Common Tern were ringed again in 2024, however this was only a very small fraction compared to previous years. There was only one individual Dunlin ringed in 2023 which was a decline of 691 birds compared to the previous year, with the total also one bird in 2024. The species with the greatest increase in the numbers of birds ringed in 2024 was Siskin, with 959 more individuals ringed compared with 2023. Depending on the winter temperature and the weather, the number of individual Siskin can vary greatly on an annual basis between northern and the southern Britain, with Siskin staying further north during milder winters.

In the table, on the previous pages, R indicates the species is on the Red List of Conservation Concern and A indicates it is on the Amber List (see the reference to Johnstone *et al.* 2023). Species where a Schedule 1 licence is required during the breeding season are indicated with S. The ringing totals are derived from the BTO database and similar numbers can be seen on the online Ringing Report: www.bto.org/volunteer-surveys/ringing/publications/online-ringing-reports.

Being able to individually identify birds has opened a window into their movements, with some species travelling large distances on a regular basis while others rarely move further than 10km. For example, a Siskin ringed in Scotland and subsequently caught in Wales the following winter is a regular occurrence and not unusual. Some of the more unusual movements, captures and life histories for 2023 and 2024 are highlighted below, particularly those that show exceptional ages. This includes a Blue Tit that was caught 22 times over the years at Rosedan, Bagillt, Flintshire, which when caught in 2024, was only two years from breaking the longevity record for this species. Considering the thousands of Blue Tits that are monitored annually, this is quite an achievement.

Highly Pathogenic Avian influenza (HPAI) is a virus that can infect individual birds easily, so an outbreak can go through a population rapidly. This has had large effects on the poultry industry but has also devastated populations of wildfowl, gulls and seabirds. At Shotton Steelworks, Flintshire, Black-headed Gull and Common Tern populations were particularly affected, which included many ringed individuals being found dead. Due to this virus, extra precautions were placed on ringers, to minimise the risk of transmission to birds or people, whilst still maintaining monitoring productivity, survival, abundance and population change through ringing activities.

Ringing provides a wealth of information to inform conservation. Standardised ringing can improve on this by providing information on adult survival, annual productivity and adult abundance. The two

schemes which are able to provide this information are the Constant Effort Site (CES) Scheme and Retrapping Adults for Survival (RAS) Scheme. Ian Spence and Giles Pepler ran their CES in 2023 and 2024 at Rhydymwyn and Kelvin Jones ran his CES at Afon Gannol for the last time in 2023. Two RAS studies were active in 2023 and 2024, both being Pied Flycatcher projects (run by Bob Harris and Peter Coffey, the latter since 1986). One other RAS project ended in 2023 which was on Siskins (run by Alan Robinson since 2002). These projects have contributed good quality data for the annual survival rates of those species. More CES and RAS projects are greatly needed and further information can be found at https://www.bto.org/get-involved/volunteer/projects/bird-ringing-scheme/ringing-surveys. An increase of just four CES projects, could result in the production of population trends specific for Wales.

I am grateful to the ringers in the area and those who visit, who give up their time to study birds in North-Fast Wales.

Ringers are reliant on members of the public reporting ringed birds that they find. Rings can also be read on live birds by members of the public, helping to 'fill in the gap' of the birds' life histories. To report a ringed bird, go to www.ring.ac, and you will be sent the details of the bird including where and when the bird was ringed. Reporting colour ringed birds is also very useful and the colour ringer can be found on this website http://cr-birding.org/



Nest records from 'Clwyd' (NB This is not the same area as VCs 50 and 51)

Volunteer nest recorders are in a unique position to be able to record how successful a particular nesting attempt is. Factors such as the number of eggs produced or the number of chicks which fledge can have a direct impact on population change of bird species. This information can then link with ringing data to monitor first year and adult survival, which gives a unique insight into the potential reasons for population decline and where action can then be taken to reverse population declines.

Since 2013, there has been a steady increase in the number of nest records submitted to the Nest Record Scheme from North-East Wales. The large drop in nest records in 2020 was due to the COVID lockdown, but thankfully the totals bounced back the following year. The total peaked in 2023 with the greatest number of nest records submitted (1354 nest records). It's worth noting that these numbers are a reflection of the effort and commitment of nest recorders and not necessarily

productivity. Productivity is however the most likely cause of the drop in numbers in 2024 (from 1,354 in 2023 to 1,176 in 2024) as many species failed in their nesting attempts due to the cold wet weather early on in the breeding cycle.

In 2023, Little Tern (322 nest records) was the most recorded species, followed by Blue Tit (280), Pied Flycatcher (261) and Great Tit (173) however in 2024, Pied Flycatcher (299) was the most nest recorded species followed closely behind by Blue Tit (298). After these was Great Tit (183), Little Tern (142) and Swallow (35). Raptor monitoring is also quite successful in North-East Wales with 10 species being monitored.

A nest record consists of recording the contents of a birds' nest and following it through its development until it succeeds or fails. With enough data, this information can give an insight into any issues a species might have while it is breeding e.g. reduced chick survival or a reduction in the number of eggs laid. For declining species, this information could be an important tool for conservation, particularly when it is incorporated into the BTO's Integrated Population Monitoring.
